



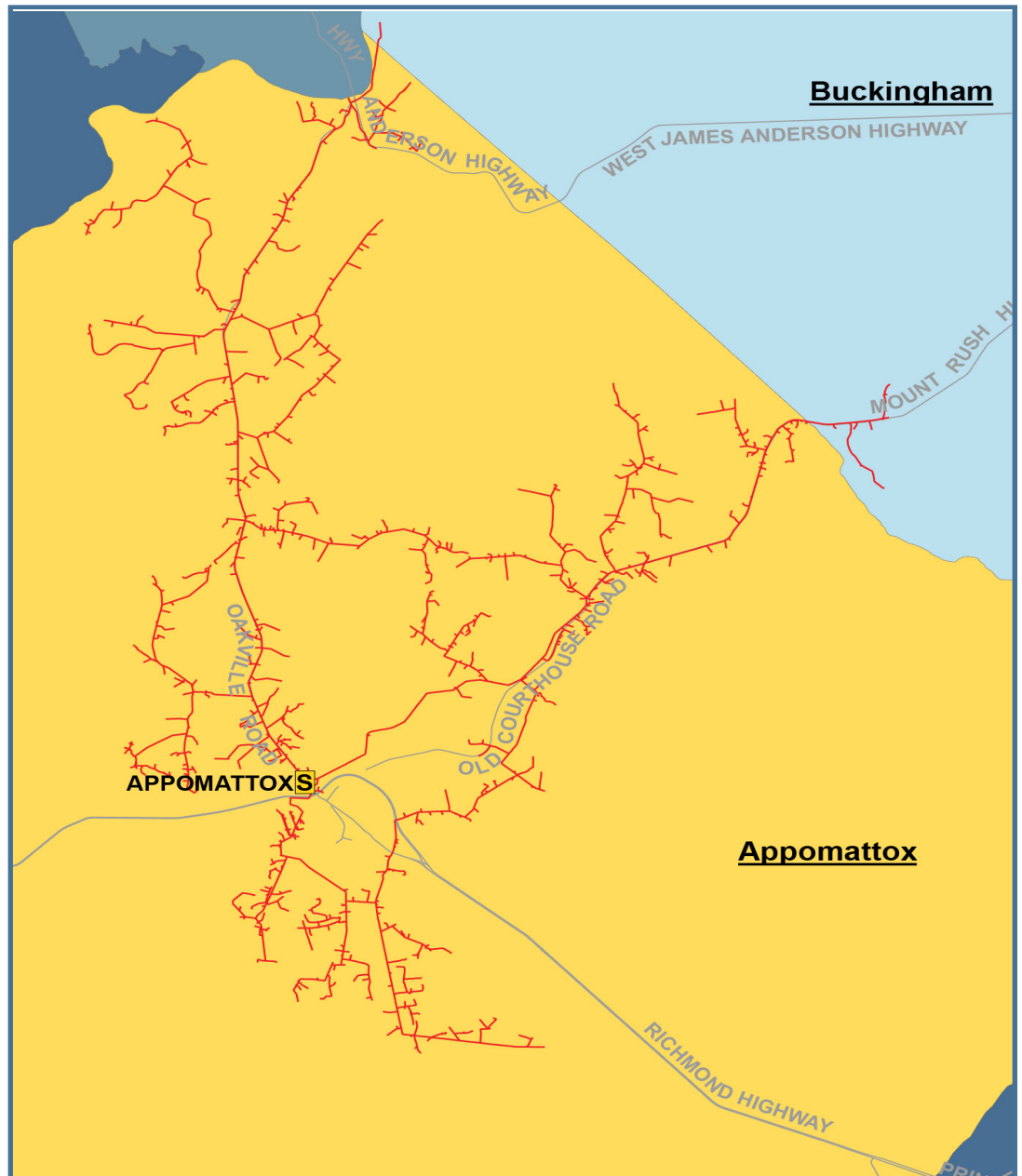
## Appomattox Fiber Broadband Build

Firefly is currently installing fiber broadband and VoIP services in Appomattox! However, poor weather and contractor shortages have combined to put Firefly about 60 days or so behind the original connection schedule. The good news is that we've ramped up significantly, and are now rolling along at a faster pace!

The Appomattox fiber build will include CVEC members served by the Appomattox substation along portions of the following roads:

We plan to complete the installations of the pre-registered customers in Appomattox by the end of April, 2019. When your address is confirmed ready for service, we'll immediately notify you, using the email provided during pre-registration. The email from Firefly will provide a link to the online system used for gathering the info needed for the next step in the process. That includes your payment method, billing preference, and desired installation appointment date. Each day we check for newly activated addresses, and promptly notify those folks of the good news. 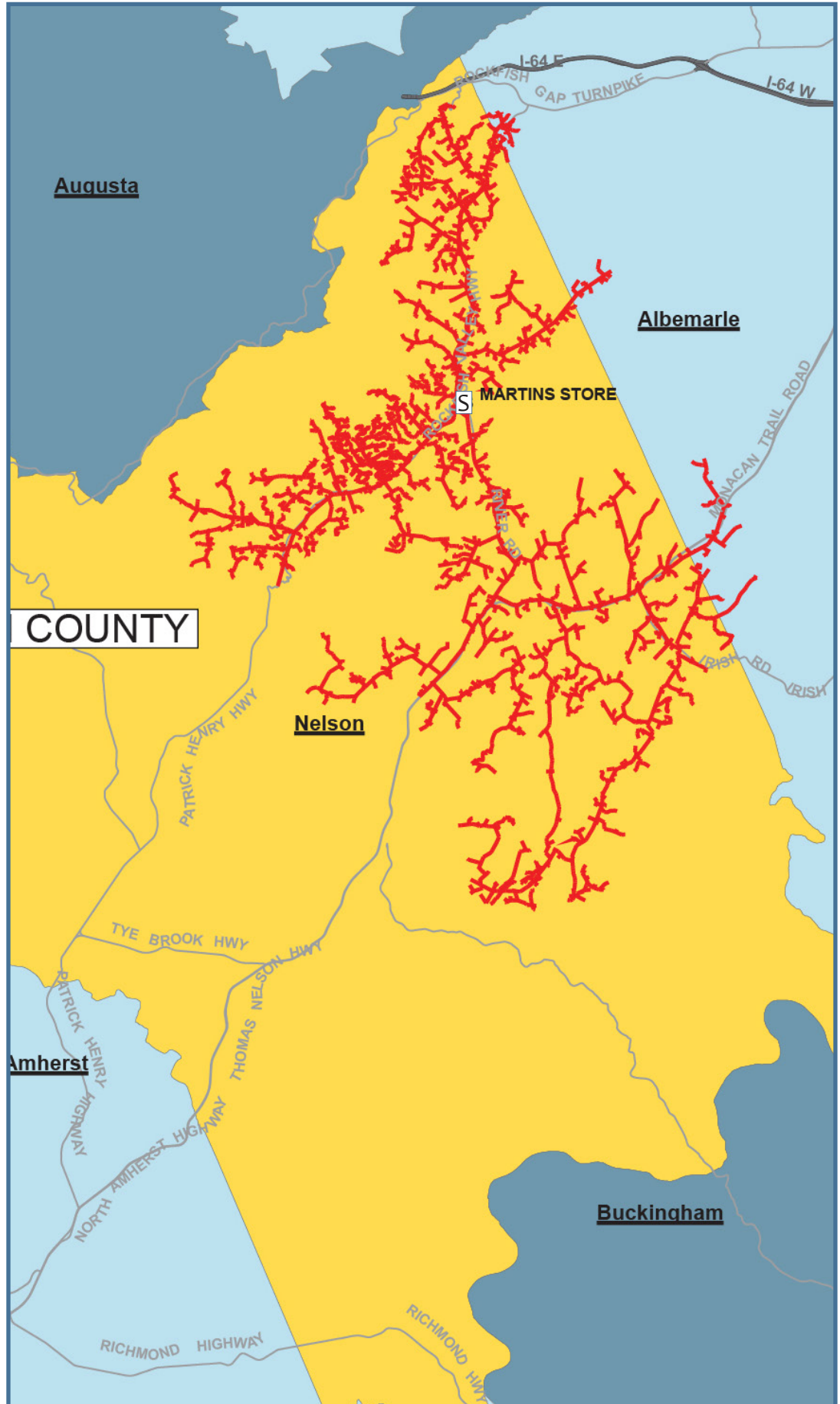
# Martins Store Fiber Broadband Build

## Zion Fiber Broadband Build

Firefly will be landing soon in Fluvanna County, beginning at CVEC's Zion Crossroads substation.

Current construction schedule indicates that installations are likely to begin in Q3, 2019.

Pre-registration signup for fiber drop construction has not yet been started. A letter will be mailed to all addresses that could be served by the Zion fiber network when pre-registration for drop construction is open.
