We are notifying you of an important update on our broadband partnership project in Madison and Greene Counties.

As part of our partnership with *Firefly Fiber Broadband<sup>SM</sup>*, your area has been divided into four service zones: McMullen, Stanardsville, Dyke and Lydia. Firefly will reference these names when providing updates on their website and when connections begin.

- Your address is located in the Lydia service zone.
- Connection to high speed internet service through Firefly in your area is expected to begin this fall.
- Please note that even though connections are expected to start this fall, it will still be a matter of months before Firefly can reach each individual home or business to connect internet and/or phone service.
